"Ahwahnee" is Lorene Salt's interpretation of the stained-glass windows in the Ahwahnee Hotel in Yosemite National Park. This class will appeal to those students who would like to try new techniques while challenging themselves by mastering complex canvaswork stitches.

The piece contains a variety of different techniques:

Laid fillings **String art stitches** **Diaper patterns** **Layered borders**

...and stitches include:

Various types of Jessicas **4- layered 8-Point Star** **Sprats Head** **Crescents**
Double Fan **Waffles** **2-colour Chilly Hollow**

...and is further **embellished with pearls and beads.**

- 18 count White Opalescent mono canvas
- 23 skeins, cards or balls of thread
- All pearls, bugle beads, beading thread, needles
